2. Following a motion by Mr. Sieber and seconded by Ms. Futterman, the minutes of the June 15, 2016 meeting were approved.

3. New Business

(a) Dkt. No.: 00080804

This matter presented to the Board by Appellate Specialist Zola to decide whether the claimant was discharged for misconduct connected with the work. The Deputy held the claimant disqualified for benefits for severe misconduct under N.J.S.A. 43:21-5(b). The Appeal Tribunal reversed, holding the claimant was not discharged for simple or severe misconduct. The Board of Review affirmed the Appeal Tribunal decision. Ms. Zola will prepare the decision.

**(b)** Dkt. No.: 00076550

This issue, presented to the Board by Appellate Specialist Zola to decide whether the claimant left work voluntarily with good cause attributable to the work. The Appeal Tribunal affirmed the Deputy and held the claimant disqualified for voluntary leaving of work under N.J.S.A. 43:21-5(a). After consideration of the record, the Board voted to reverse the Appeal Tribunal holding that the claimant left work with good cause. Ms. Zola will prepare the decision.

**(c)** Dkt. No.: 00080335

This matter was tabled.

There being no further business to transact, a motion was made by Mr. Sieber to adjourn the meeting. Ms. Futterman seconded the motion.
